

## Walking and Cycling Index Mapping Attributes

The Walking and Cycling Index cycle route data is classified into four categories recorded under the column name “**CDO**” with descriptions outlined below:

<b>Segregated Cycle Lane</b>	Cycle tracks within road, physically separated from traffic and pedestrians.
<b>Traffic Free</b>	Traffic free cycle routes away from the road.
<b>Signed Route</b>	Signed cycle routes on low-trafficked and low speed roads.
<b>Surface Change</b>	Cycle track level with footpath without physical segregation e.g. kerb or verge but distinguished by different surface type or surface colour.

Additional attributes outlined in the table below were Boolean **Yes/No** values which included:

<b>Two-way</b>	Cycle tracks that allow two way movement.
<b>Bollard Protected</b>	Cycle tracks that include bollard protection from vehicular or pedestrian traffic.
