## How do I access the Flood Data?

Step 1: Complete the data access request form available at: https://forms.gle/3UKLSDcKX8EQSvLP9

- You must provide an explanation as to why you want the data and how it will be used.
- You must agree to the Terms and Conditions in relation to the use of the Flood Data.

Your request will be sent to Dublin City Council for review and approval. (This may take up to 48 hours).

Step 2: Creating an account and logging in to the Smart Dublin Open Data Platform:

- 1. You will receive a link by email. Check you're SPAM folder to make sure the email hasn't gone there.
- 2. The link will ask you to change your password.
- 3. Using the username and the password you will need to go to data.smartdublin.ie and at the very end of the page you will see the following:
